Anna and Guy would remain together until her passing.

When Anna began to show signs of decline this March, we brought her to the clinic. There, they found that her kidneys and liver were failing, so helped her pass peacefully.

Anna was brave and confident while also quiet and endearing. She seemed to be a constant source of support for Guy, who had always been the shyer of the two. Anna was especially rambunctious in the morning, often initiating play with Guy. We will remember her strength and tenacity.
